Prof. Adnan Enshassi is a Distinguished Professor of Construction Engineering and Management at the Islamic University of Gaza (IUG), Palestine, and currently serves as a Visiting Professor in the Department of Construction Economics and Management at Technische Universität Berlin (TU Berlin), Germany. He holds a Ph.D. from the University of Liverpool (UK), an M.Sc. from Loughborough University (UK), and a B.Sc. in Civil Engineering from Suez Canal University (Egypt).

His research focuses on post-war reconstruction, disaster management, the circular economy, occupational safety and health, sustainability, education and training, and procurement management.

With more than 30 years of experience in academia and consulting, Prof. Enshassi has authored over 250 scholarly publications, served as a visiting professor at leading universities across the USA, Germany, Austria, and the UK, and provided expert advice to organizations such as the World Bank, UNDP, and PECДАР. A Fellow of TWAS and the Palestinian Academy of Science and Technology, he has received numerous honors, including the IUG Gold Medal, the Scientific Research Award for Science and Engineering, and prestigious fellowships from the Alexander von Humboldt (AvH), Fulbright, and DAAD. He is fluent in Arabic, English, and German.
